PROCEDURE FOR MALAYSIAN CITIZENS WISHING TO EXIT THE COUNTRY FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONTINUING STUDIES AND WORK

The above mentioned subject is respectfully referred.

2. With reference to the Cabinet decision on 17 June 2020, it is hereby informed that students who wish to leave the country for the purposes of continuing their studies are **allowed** without obtaining prior permission from the Malaysian Department of Immigration. This includes students who have entered Malaysia during the Movement Control Order (MCO) period.
3. The categories of students allowed to leave the country are those who wish to continue their studies, or have just obtained an offer to study and students who wish to sit for examinations. They will need to produce a student pass / visa / long-term pass / offer letter / letter to sit for examinations in addition to other related documents, to the Immigration Officer at the border.
4. Malaysian citizens who have entered Malaysia during the MCO period and wish to leave the country for work or reside overseas are **allowed** with the condition that they produce evidentiary documents such as a Resident Pass / Long-Term Pass / Work Permit or other related documents to the Immigration officer at the border. This includes Malaysian citizens who work with shipping companies and need to sign-on to a ship overseas. Letters and related documents from the company need to be presented to the Immigration Officer at the border.
5. For Malaysian citizens who need to go overseas for other purposes other than for studies, work and residence such as to attend a meeting / seminar / exhibition or for emergency and business purposes, must still **apply for permission** from the Director-General of Immigration for approval.
6. This order is enforceable commencing **24 June 2020**. Your cooperation is requested to inform all borders of this order. Your attention in this matter is appreciated.

1. **PROCEDURE FOR THE ENTRY OF FOREIGN EXPATRIATES (CATEGORIES AS STATED IN PARA 2)**
 - 1.1 Undergo the PCR or COVID-19 swab test with a negative result within **three (3) days** before entry into Malaysia;
 - 1.2 Download the MySejahtera app on a smartphone and complete all required information;
 - 1.3 Undergo a COVID-19 screening test at the border entry;
 - 1.4 Undergo self-quarantine at home for 14 days in compliance with the quarantine procedures set by the National Disaster Agency (NADMA) and the Ministry of Health (MOH) except for foreigners arriving from Green Zone countries (Brunei, Singapore, New Zealand and Australia); and
 - 1.5 Comply with Malaysian all entry procedures and set immigration inspection procedures.
