



## OBJECTIVE

The AmChamREPRESENT Awards 2021 recognize and showcase business excellence across four award categories: (1) Leadership Transformation; (2) Digital Transformation; (3) Business Transformation; and (4) Human Capital Transformation.

## AWARD CATEGORIES

### LEADERSHIP TRANSFORMATION AWARD (INDIVIDUAL: 1 MNC, 1 SME\*)

This award recognizes an individual who has driven significant and systemic change in their organization to lead the transformation of their company. This award takes into consideration the following, but is not limited to:

- Agile leadership and adaptability to evolving circumstances
- Strong Commitment to CSR and environmental sustainability
- Inclusive leadership and accountability
- Fostering positive organizational culture and promoting employee well-being

### DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION AWARD (COMPANY: 1 MNC, 1 SME\*)

This award recognizes a company for its excellence in technological innovation and digital transformation. This could include, but is not limited to:

- Product Innovation/ New Product Development
- System modernization and adoption of new internal processes
- Improved digital experience for clients/customers
- Change management in response to digital disruption of traditional business model

### BUSINESS TRANSFORMATION AWARD (COMPANY: 14 AWARDS)

This award category recognizes one company that has excelled in driving business transformation in one of the 7 industries or 7 business functions listed below.

- Sectoral Sub-categories: Aerospace & Defense; Financial Services; Healthcare; Small & Medium Enterprises; Supply Chain, Transportation, & Logistics; Technology, Media & Telecommunications; Travel & Leisure
- Functional Sub-categories: AmCham Women, Cybersecurity, Environment & Sustainability, Government & Regional Affairs, Human Capital, Legal & IPR, Marketing & Communications

### HUMAN CAPITAL TRANSFORMATION AWARD (COMPANY: 1 MNC, 1 SME\*)

This award recognizes a company for its organization-wide commitment to transforming its human capital and workforce to be better equipped for the future of work. This award takes into consideration the following, but is not limited to:

- Effective Skills Training Programs
- Promotion of Diversity & Inclusion Policies and Programs
- Initiatives that have pushed (and/or are pushing) the boundaries on people strategy, employee engagement, and performance management

\*A company is categorized as a small and medium-sized enterprise (SME) if its group revenue is up to \$100 million or if it has a maximum of 200 employees ([SME Working Capital | Overview | Enterprise Singapore - enterprisesg.gov.sg](#))



## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Individuals and companies from AmCham member companies (affiliated with at least one of the 28 regional AmChams) are eligible to participate.
- Please note that applications are limited to one entry per company/individual per category. For the third category on Business Transformation, applications can be submitted for one sectoral and one functional sub-category.
- A company/individual may apply for more than one category. Please submit a new application for each additional category.

## ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The contributions of the individuals and companies submitted in the applications will be assessed on three key criteria:

### (1) Innovation

Programs and initiatives in the application will be assessed for their innovative approach and should include details on how the individual and/or company worked towards creating a novel product or program. Some examples include, but are not limited to:

- Developing a new staff or community program in response to the COVID-19 pandemic
- Designing a new product that is unique and caters to the evolving needs of the market
- Improving internal processes and operations, for instance through the adoption of new digital tools

### (2) Implementation

Applications will be assessed on the effectiveness of program and product delivery and should therefore include a concise overview of the implementation plan and metrics. This may include, but is not limited to:

- Implementation process, including timelines, resourcing, and key performance indicators
- Demonstration of efficient program delivery/product development showcasing organizational agility

### (3) Impact

Impact of the programs highlighted in the applications will also be assessed. Details on the progress made against key project metrics may include, but are not limited to:

- Quantitative results depicting the transformation journey, i.e., increase in sales/revenue, and improvement in staff/customer satisfaction
- Qualitative assessment of the impact of transformation, i.e., staff and client testimonials, and survey feedback highlighting project impact
