### PRESS STATEMENT

8<sup>th</sup> October 2020

#### CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER IN KLANG

The National Security Council (NSC) under the Federal Government has announced the implementation of the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in the Klang District.

In this regard, the NSC has decided that all economic sectors are to continue operations with strict compliance to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).

In addition to this, the following steps which have been agreed upon by the NSC will be implemented to control the transmission of COVID-19 in the Klang District. The areas involved in the Klang District CMCO is attached in an appendix to this statement.

#### Security

- The Royal Malaysian Police (RMP) will implement control measures including road blocks with the cooperation of the Malaysian Armed Forces (ATM), the Malaysian Civil Defence Force (APM) and the People's Volunteer Corps (RELA).

#### Activity

- It is advised for only the head of the household to leave the house for the purposes of obtaining food supply / household needs. Those at high risk are not encouraged to go out into public, open and congested areas.
- Restaurants, shops / dining outlets, grocery and convenience stores as well as stalls are permitted to operate between 6.00am until 10.00pm.
- The buying of food is encouraged only through methods such as drive-through, delivery or take-away. Dining-in is not permitted.
- Petrol station operating hours are between 6.00am until 11.00pm.
- Market operations are as follows:
  1. Wholesale Markets : 4.00am until 2.00pm
  2. Regular Markets : 6.00am until 2.00pm
  3. Wet Markets : 6.00am until 12.00pm

- Night markets are not allowed to operate during this period.
- Clinics, Government and private hospitals are permitted to operate on a 24-hour basis.
- Pharmacies and drugstores may operate from 8.00am to 11.00pm.
- Public transportation such as buses, taxis, and e-hailing services are permitted to operate from 6.00am to 12.00am.

### **Education and social premises**

- Mosques, *suraus*, non-Muslim houses of worship, Public & Private Institutes of Higher Education, Skill Training Institutes, schools, kindergartens, nurseries, *tahfiz* centers, child care centers, public parks, recreation centers, indoor & outdoor playgrounds are closed during this period.  
All house of worship activities are suspended for the duration of this period.

### **Sports, Recreation, Social and Cultural Activities**

- All sports, recreational, social and cultural activities are not permitted from 9 October 2020 to 23 October 2020.

Any developments based on the COVID-19 cases in this district will be examined from time to time.

Faced with a 3<sup>rd</sup> COVID-19 wave situation, the State Government emphasizes that strong cooperation between industry, the community and government is necessary for us to cut the transmission chain or to flatten the curve of this virus.

Always adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures, wear a face mask when it is necessary to leave the house, use the SeLangkah application when entering any premises and always maintain a physical distance of at least 1 meter. *InsyAllah* we will win.
