Extract from YB Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob's Announcement today, 12 October 2020 -

Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in Selangor, WP Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya

The special meeting convened today heard confirmation from the Ministry of Health (MOH) on the increase of positive cases in Selangor, WP Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya.

After obtaining advice from MOH and taking into account the increase of cases and transmission occurring in Klang in Petaling and increase in cases in Gombak and other districts.

To curb the transmission of this virus, the special National Security Council (NSC) meeting today agreed to implement the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in Selangor, WP Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya effective 12.01am, 14 October until 27 October 2020.

Prohibited activities are as follows:

- Movement in and out or cross-district movement is not permitted. However, for employees who need to cross districts, they must show an employee pass or an endorsement letter from their employer.
- Only two persons from each household is permitted to go out to buy household needs.
- All schools, higher education institutes, vocational institutes, kindergartens, nurseries, tahfiz centres, public parks and recreational centres are closed.
- Mosques and non-Muslim houses of worship are closed.
- All sports, recreational, social and cultural activities including weddings are not permitted.
- Entertainment centres and nightclubs are also not permitted.

However, all economic activities in Selangor, WP Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya are still permitted to operate as normal.

A detailed list of SOP will be announced by the NSC in the near future.
