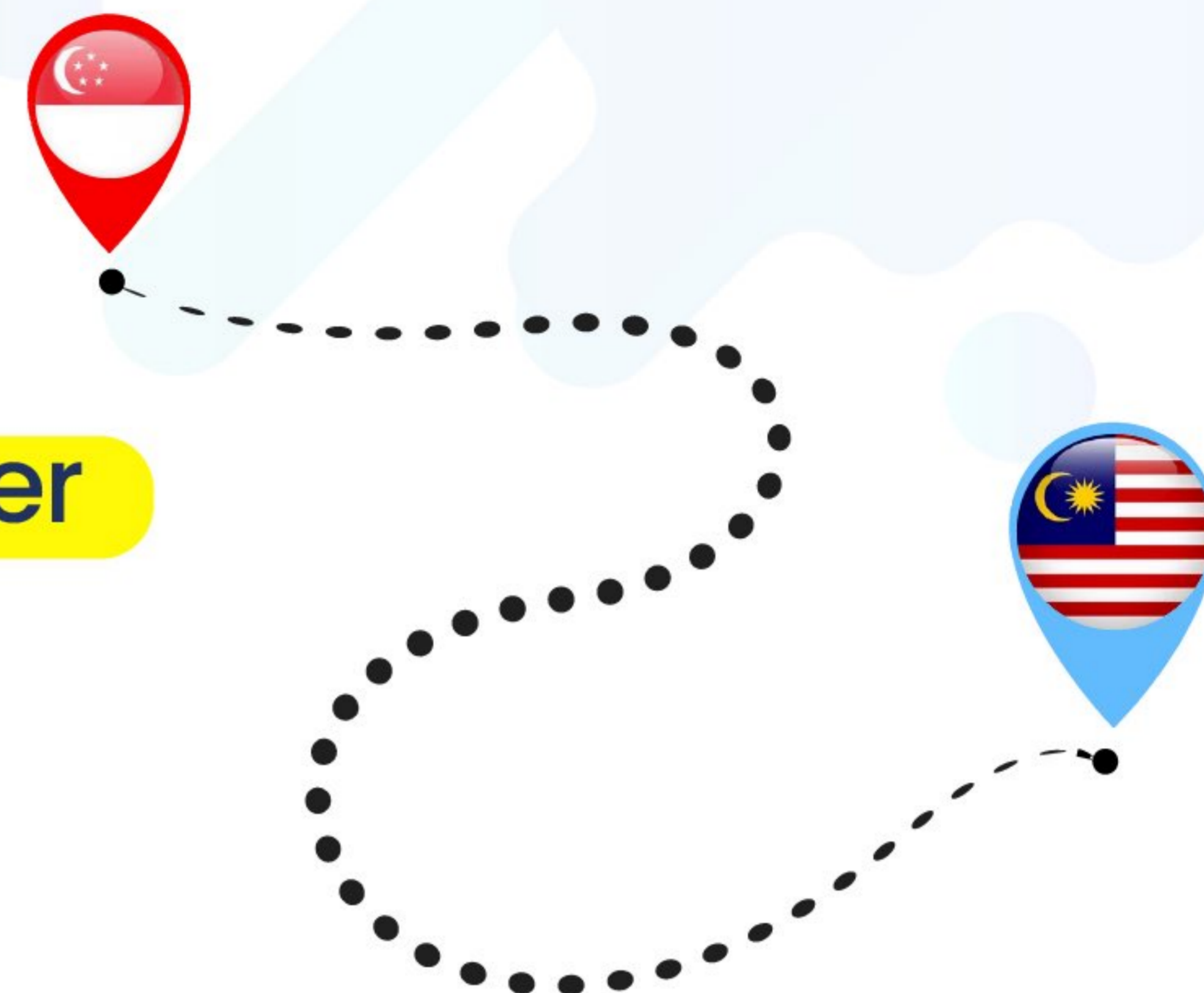


CROSSING THE MALAYSIA-SINGAPORE LAND BORDER



KEMENTERIAN KESIHATAN MALAYSIA

Fully vaccinated travellers
are allowed to cross the
Malaysia and Singapore land border
from 1 April 2022



Travellers are NOT required to:



Apply for entry approval



Undergo quarantine



Take a pre-departure test



Take an on-arrival test



This applies to all travellers crossing the border by land regardless of medium of transportation.

ON-ARRIVAL PROCEDURES FOR TRAVELLERS FROM 1 APRIL 2022

On-Arrival Professional RTK-Ag test

Travellers 7 years and above are required to undergo a professional RTK-Ag test within 24 hours of arrival



Children aged 6 years old and below are exempted from the on-arrival test



The professional RTK-Ag test can be done at any health facility of your choice



COVID-19 breathalyser and professional RTK-Ag test are also available on-arrival



Cost of on-arrival professional RTK-Ag test will be borne by the traveller



Children and adolescents 17 years of age and younger are excluded from quarantine regardless of vaccination status

DISCONTINUED ITEMS FROM 1 APRIL 2022



From 1 April 2022, the following will be discontinued for travellers entering Malaysia:

3 DIGITAL TRACKER



4 HIGH-RISK COUNTRIES LIST

*COVID-19 screening operations by private health facilities are still in operations as travellers will have the option to undergo professional RTK-Ag test or breathalyser test upon arrival at the airport.

PROCEDURE FOR TRAVELLERS ENTERING MALAYSIA FROM 1 APRIL 2022



BEFORE DEPARTURE





- 1 Download MySejahtera app 
- 2 Complete the pre-departure form via the Traveller icon on MySejahtera 
 - ➔ **Fully Vaccinated:**
Digital Traveller's Card will be issued
 - ➔ **Partially Vaccinated /Unvaccinated:**
Digital Home Surveillance Order (HSO) will be issued 
- 3 Undergo a PCR test 2 days before departure for travellers 7 years and above 
 - ➔ Travellers with previous COVID-19 infection (6-60 days before departure) are required to undergo a professional RTK-Ag test 2 days before departure
- 4 Purchase a travel and COVID-19 insurance (for non-Malaysian citizens) 

UPON ARRIVAL



- 1 Undergo a professional RTK-Ag test within 24 hours of arrival 
- 2 Undergo a mandatory 5 days quarantine for partially or unvaccinated travellers 

RTK-Ag test:

 - ➔ The professional RTK-Ag test can be done at any health facility of your choice 
 - ➔ COVID-19 breathalyser OR professional RTK-Ag tests, on arrival are also available at the airport 
 - ➔ Cost of on-arrival professional RTK-Ag test will be borne by travellers 
 - ➔ Children aged 6 years old and below are exempted from the on-arrival test
