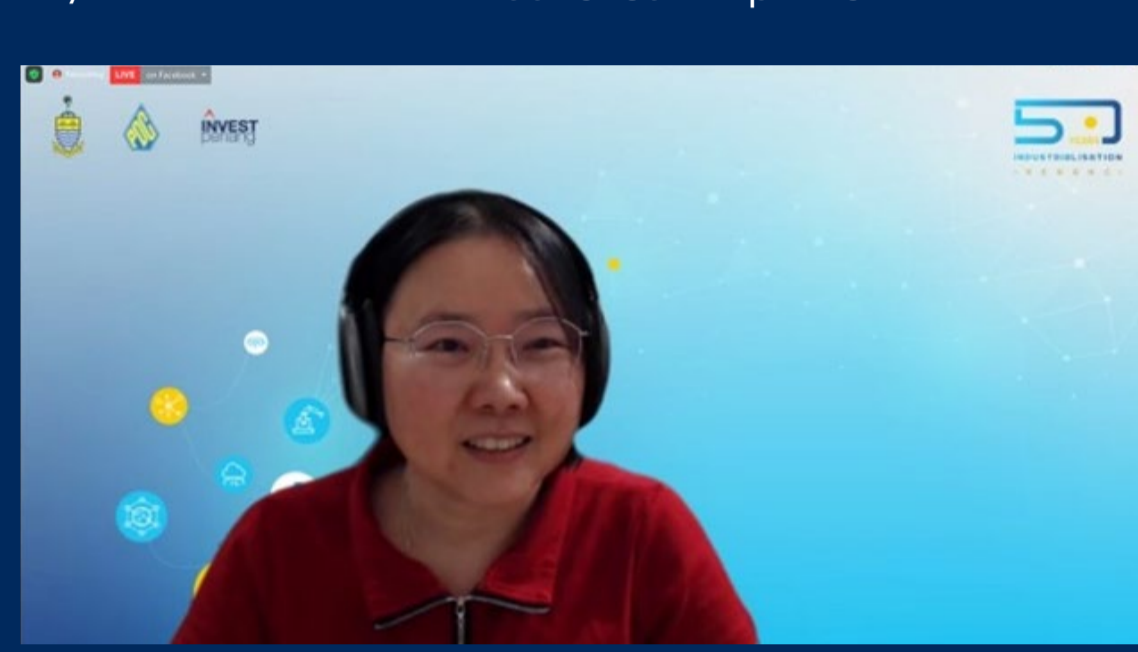


Debugging for the Future

Dr. Angie Ng, from Intel's Internet of Things Group, was a featured speaker in InvestPenang's '50 Years of Excellence and Beyond' webinar on 23 May. She shared essential insights into the workings of Cloud-based Remote Debugging (CBRD), the remote debugging tool her team designed to resolve customer issues, from anywhere in the world.



Angie then shared how her team leveraged on the CBRD to develop the System Cloud for University, an initiative enabling students to virtually access simulated engineering instruments and laboratory setups. This platform was launched in April 2021.

Grow, Harvest & Donate - Home Hydroponic Program



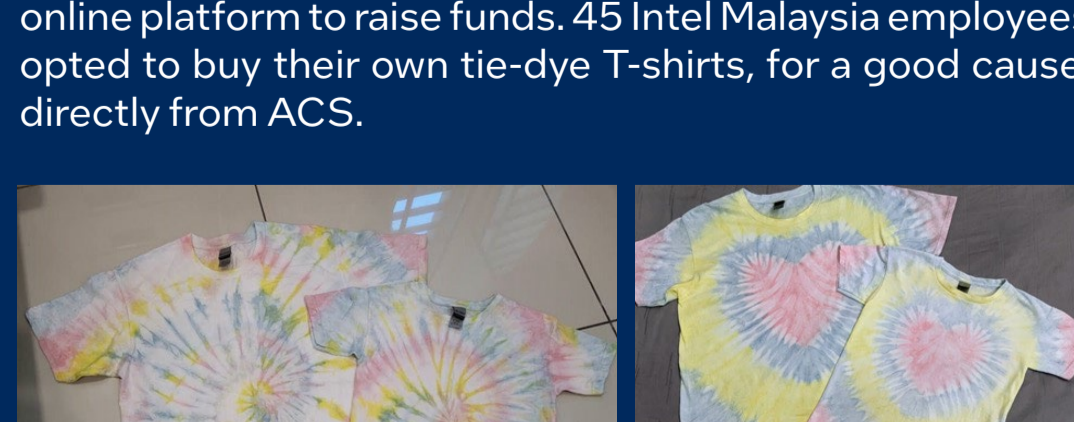
