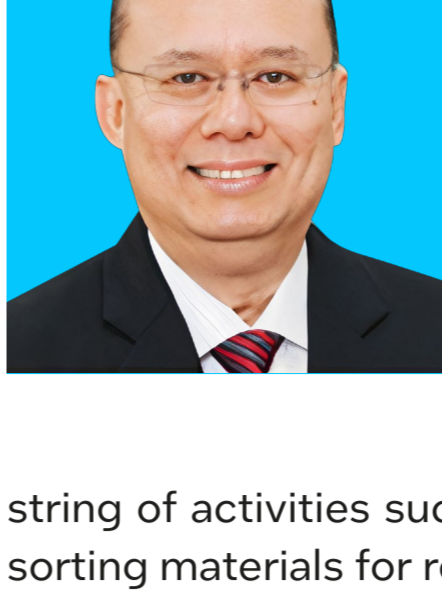


Foreword

As you may have heard, this year we are celebrating a truly remarkable milestone – Intel Malaysia’s 50th (IM50) anniversary. Our journey began when Intel Corporation chose Malaysia as its first offshore site in 1972, starting with an initial investment of USD320,000 and 100 employees. Intel has invested over USD8 billion in Malaysia since then, with an additional USD7 billion investment for the next 10 years. Our site continues to expand and we are home to a 15,000-strong workforce. We continue contributing to the nation and we jointly celebrate the IM50 with our community by setting a goal to contribute 50,000 volunteer hours to schools and NGOs in Penang and Kedah. I am very pleased to share with you that we have already reached 43,000 hours so far, and we would be absolutely delighted if we hit the 50,000 hours mark by this year end.

I’m also proud to share that the Malaysia Public Affairs (MY PA) team, which is part of Corporate Services Malaysia (CSM), organized the annual CSM Global Give Back Day 2022 at Phor Tay High School, Penang. CSM volunteers connected with the students in a

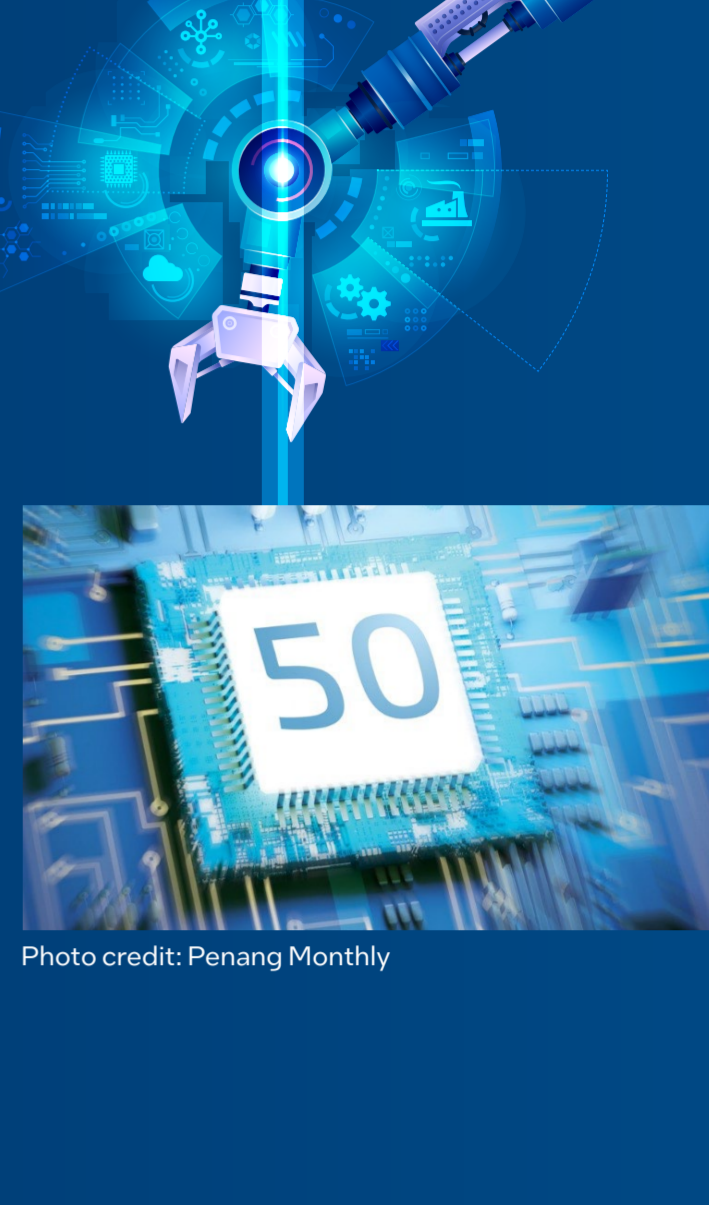
In the News: Intel Malaysia

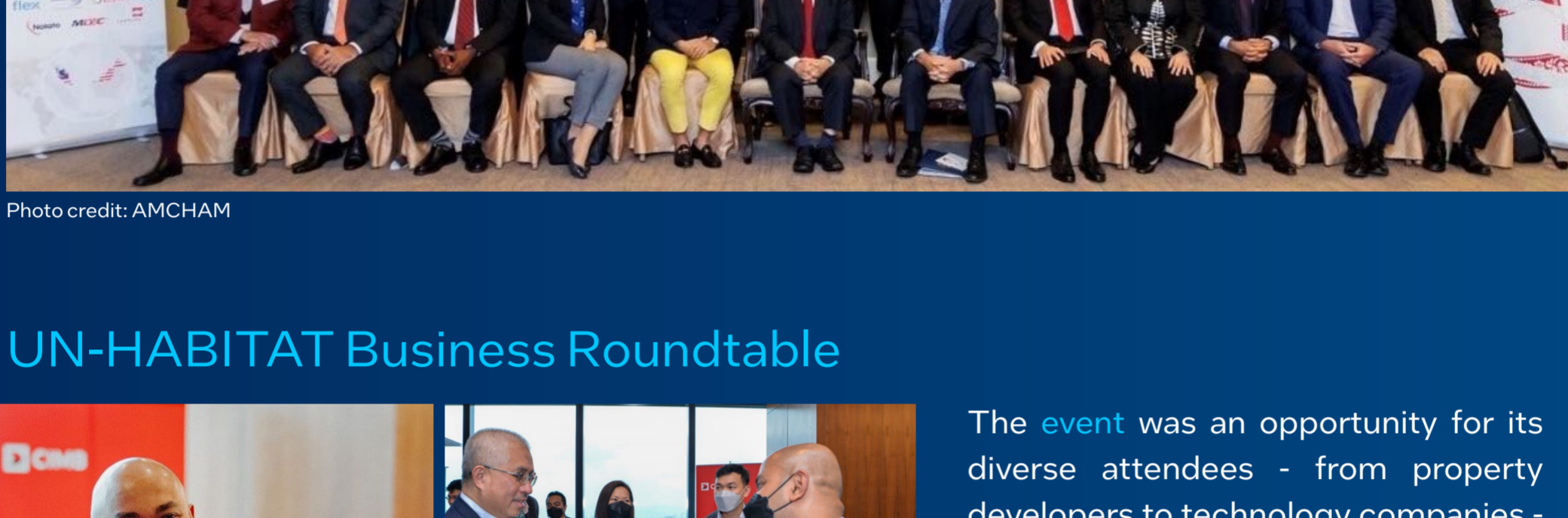
The event was graced by the Penang Chief Minister, and around 300 industry members were in attendance.

'Be a River Ranger' Program



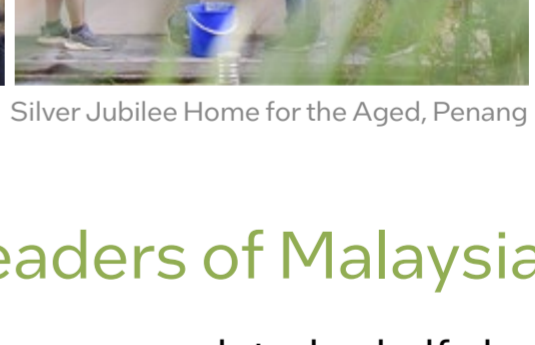
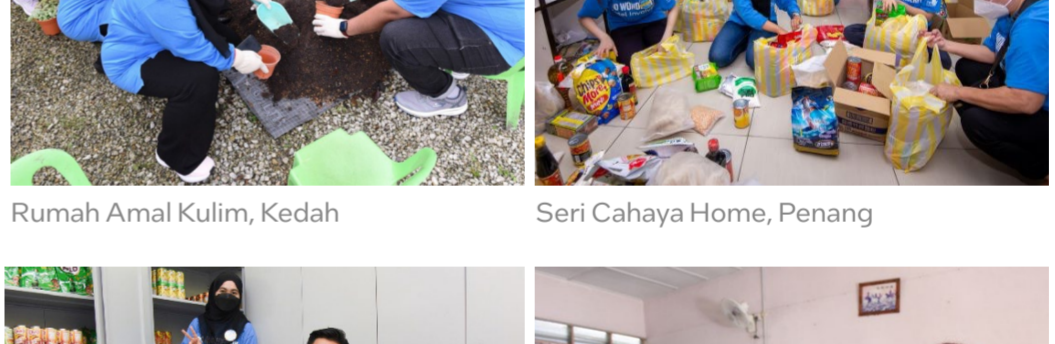

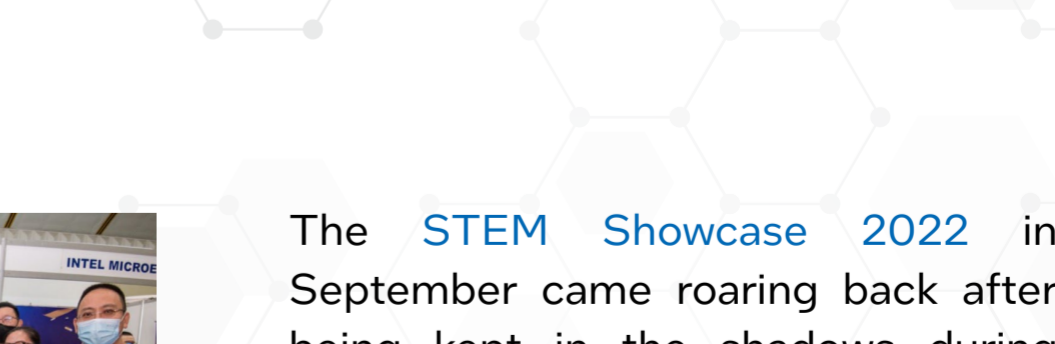
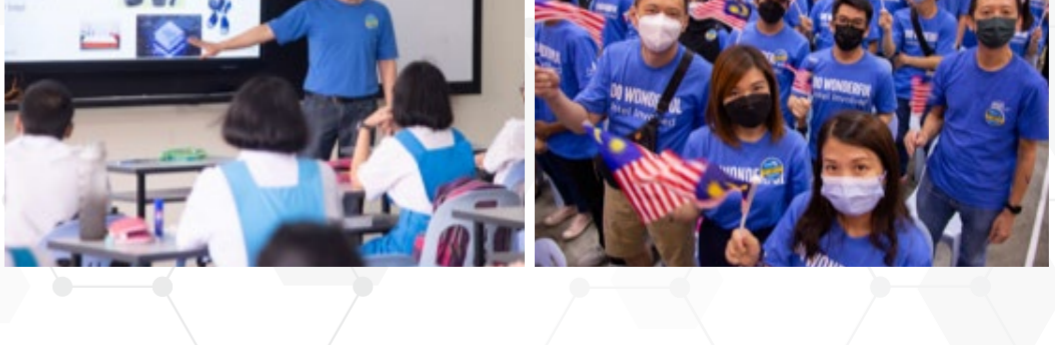


Creating Positive Environmental Impact on Merdeka Day
